CCQ Website to include Club Brochures from 2018

The Caravan Clubs of Queensland (CCQ), from early next year, 2018, will allow all affiliated clubs the opportunity to have a downloadable brochure attached to their club details on the CCO website.

Brochures may be viewed on-line, downloaded to a PC or tablet, or printed. This will allow interested parties to print the brochures and take them for further consideration.

Clubs are required to prepare their own brochure and comply with a few conditions

The brochure should include a club logo, contact details, and information about how the club functions, where the club goes, what the club does and anything else that you want to tell prospective members about your club. Photos can be included.

A well-presented brochure will go a long way to attract the future members that your club seeks.

The brochure must comply with the following requirements to be accepted.

- Be a single page A4 document
- Be either a PDF or Microsoft Word document (Word documents will be converted to PDF)
- Final documents have a file size of 2MB or less
- Include the Club name
- Include contact details
- Include the publication date
- The brochure must contain the following logo and statements as the footer of the document.
