

DIRECTIONS TO 2021 STATE RALLY

FROM BRISBANE AND THE EAST:


Travel the Warrego Highway (A2) and the Toowoomba by-pass (Toll Road) to the Gore Highway (A39). Take the exit to Pittsworth (Toowoomba Road). After entering the 60k zone the High School should be on your left. Immediately after the school **TURN LEFT** into **Factory Street** (beware of school children). At the "T" junction **TURN RIGHT** into **Yandilla Street**. Take the next **TURN RIGHT** into **Steele Street** cross over Bayley Street and **TURN RIGHT** into the **Showgrounds**. If traffic is banked up pull to the side of the road and off the bitumen if practical. **Do NOT block the roadway!**

FROM MILLMERRAN AND THE WEST:

Travel the Gore Highway (A39) to the Pittsworth exit. This will become **Yandilla Street**. Stay on Yandilla Street travelling through 2 roundabouts then **TURN LEFT** into **Steele Street** cross over Bayley Street and **TURN RIGHT** into the **Showgrounds**. If traffic is banked up pull to the side of the road and off the bitumen if practical. **Do NOT block the** roadway!

FROM WARWICK AND THE SOUTH:

Travel the New England Highway and exit to Clifton then travel via the Clifton-Pittsworth Road to Pittsworth or (preferred option) detour through Felton and travel via the Felton Pittsworth Road. On Entering the 60k zone continue past Factory Street and take the next **TURN RIGHT** into **Steele Street** cross over Bayley Street and **TURN RIGHT** into the **Showgrounds**. If traffic is banked up pull to the side of the road and off the bitumen if practical. **Do NOT block the roadway!**



MEET & GREET

You will be greeted at the gate and in the queue when you line up with your van to enter the showgrounds on the 16th September 2021. Your Meet and Greet Team will be wearing floral shirts so you will know who they are.

Please be ready with your Covid-19 Declaration forms or the more easier and quicker method of the Old Checkin App for the all-important check-in at the gate. Your registration statement is also required as proof of payment. The Team are ready to help you ease into this rally so you can enjoy your experience at Pittsworth.



HOUSEKEEPING

BRAZIERS welcome but must be off the ground and self-contained.

POWER LEADS TESTED & TAGGED It is a safety requirement that power leads be tested and tagged. Testing will be available on **Thursday 16th from 10am until 2.30pm** in the Animal Nursery (behind the Blue Sky Caravan) near the office. A small cost is involved.

SPECIAL BINS will be placed around the grounds to provide for the usual recyclable bottles & cans (all proceeds will be donated to **Lifeflight**)

ALL RUBBISH to be wrapped before being disposed of.

WATER HOOKUP: Please ensure you arrive with full tanks of water in your van. There will be water hook up but we are asking rally participants to conserve water where possible.

GREY/SULLAGE WATER: Sullage water is to be distributed onto the ground. \cdot A stocking must be placed over the end of sullage hoses to catch all solids. \cdot Sullage hoses must be moved from time to time to avoid pools forming. \cdot Sullage water must not encroach onto neighbouring sites or walkways. \cdot Use of washing machines should be extremely limited.

BLACK WATER: Toilet cassettes and night buckets are to be emptied into the approved dump point only, NOT the toilets.

PETS: Pets must be confined in an enclosed area or restrained on a leash of two (2) metres or less. Pets are not allowed in buildings, marquees, eating areas or any communal area. Owners are responsible for the behaviour of their pets and shall clean-up any 'mess' deposited by their pets. Dogs must be kept under control at all times and on a short lead when in public places. Dogs are prohibited from food areas, group gatherings where food is consumed, formal meetings and/or in any hall or marquee. Owners must ensure that their dog is not a nuisance to other rally attendees. Dogs should not be left unattended for long hours when their barking/howling can be a nuisance to neighbours. Dogs that have a tendency to snap or bite must be muzzled when outside their van/annexe. Owners are responsible for cleaning up any mess deposited by their pet.

ALCOHOL: Consumption of alcohol is restricted to caravans and designated happy hour areas.

GLASS: Please be responsible with the use of glass as the Pittsworth Showgrounds is a major equestrian area and be aware that glass restrictions are in place, especially in the arena. Any broken glass must be totally removed.

SMOKING: Smoking is not allowed in buildings, marquees, eating areas or any communal area.

COVID-19: Members must be aware of and comply with all QLD Health regulations and COVID-19 plans and safety directives that apply at the time of the rally.

COVID SAFE EVENT.

To ensure this is possible there are several key issues, listed below, that **ALL** attendees must adhere to as a condition of entry to the rally.

- You must abide by ALL Queensland health regulations that are current during the time of the rally. You
 will be advised of any alterations to the current regulations prior to and during the rally.
- You must sign into the grounds EVERY time you enter. The easiest way to achieve this is via the Queensland QR App on your smart phone. There will be staff and the appropriate QR code at the entrance to help you achieve this. If you do not have that App, then it would be advisable to download it before arriving at the rally. If you do not have the App at your disposal a paper entry form must be completed every time you enter the grounds. Once again there will be staff there to assist you.
- **REMEMBER:** NO SIGN IN = NO ENTRY with NO EXCEPTIONS. Queensland Health and the Queensland Police Service can impose substantial fines for those who do not comply with this and any other Covid regulations.
- You must social distance wherever possible while moving around the grounds. If you are unable to do so, then a mask should be worn. Make sure you always carry a mask with you.
- You must sanitise your hands whenever you enter a building or around food areas. The committee has gone to great lengths ensuring sanitising stations will be in all the appropriate positions. It is advisable to always carry a personal sanitiser.
- You must obey all directional signs when entering and exiting any building.
- You must wear a mask if you are uncomfortable with seating arrangement at venues. In most instances once people are seated the "social distancing" regulation does not apply.
- You must NEVER move any seating from its designated position. We will make every effort to ensure seating arrangements are more than adequate for the number of people at each inside venue. Seating at tables will be in accordance with Qld Health regulations and must not be increased or changed for any reason.

Here are some suggestions to get you into the rally faster and stay healthy.

- 1. Have your phone on hand and be prepared to check in all persons within your vehicle. There will be meet and greet people before the entry with the QR code in hand and ask you some basic questions. Use the code and answer the questions truthfully. If you do not have the phone App, then have your paper entry form completed **before** arriving. If you don't have these tasks completed before you reach the gate you will be parked to one side until you do. **Remember: Non-compliance means no entry!**
- 2. Prior to the rally ensure you look after your health, avoid hot spots. If you find you have been in a hot spot prior to the rally, get tested and remain isolated until you receive a negative result. You will NOT be admitted if you do not comply. Giving false information to our staff prior at entry may result in fines being imposed by Qld Health.
- 3. Keep a supply of masks in your caravan in case Qld Health regulations change during the rally.
- 4. Should you feel unwell at the rally you must return immediately to your caravan and contact rally staff. A list of contacts will appear in the rally program.
- 5. While waiting for assistance, and if you are fit enough, start making a list of the close contacts you have been with and places/areas you have been over the previous several days. That type of information is vital should contact tracing be required.
- 6. There are no Covid test sites in Pittsworth so if you wish to get tested at any stage during the rally check out Qld Health web site for details of your closest testing site.

It is extremely important that you have read, understand, and obey the requirements above. Queensland Health and the Queensland Police Service have the power to impose substantial fines on any person who does not comply with any Covid rule or regulation.

On Market Day, public access will be strictly limited to the markets area only. We have undertaken these measures to ensure the health and safety of all our registered rally attendees.






CLUB FLAGS






Disc Bowls Pairs Championship at the Pittsworth CCQ State Rally
