

OUR CLUB:

The Moreton Bay Caravan Club Inc (MBCC) has been active since 6th February 1999. The Club provides an opportunity for you to:

- ❖ Meet people, make new friends, go to interesting places
- ❖ Swap caravanning ideas and experiences with experienced caravanners.

Getting there: Members are given a list of venues within a 350 km radius for the year. Each

month you will receive directions, a guide to venue facilities and the cost per night. The venue is booked from the Wednesday to Monday (staying 5 nights) inclusive over the last full weekend of the month, but members can

extend their stay if they are so inclined.

Meals: Members usually eat out together on a Friday night at a venue and together

at the facility on Saturday night followed by games.

Morning/afternoon tea: Join the group for a friendly chat if you are inclined with happy

hour with a drink and a chat about 4pm.

Meetings: A club general meeting is held on the Friday afternoon to keep everyone

informed. Meetings usually last approximately an hour.

Pets: Pets are welcome. They must abide by the usual venue pet rules, be well

behaved and happy to stay within the confines of the van whilst mum and dad enjoy the company of the group get togethers. For safety requirements

pets are not permitted in group gatherings/functions.

HOW TO APPLY TO JOIN:

MBCC is a small club but currently has some vacancies. Visitors who are seeking to join the Club are required to attend <u>three (3) rallies</u> within 6 months as a 'visitor'. (Visitors are asked to pay \$7.50 to cover the costs of public liability insurance and administration, plus the daily camping fee for that venue).
