PRESIDENT'S REPORT FEBRUARY 2021

In spite of the year just past I do hope that you all enjoyed a Merry Christmas and are looking at a happy New Year, and planning much travel. I see that if you travel to Tasmania between March 1 and June 30 you will be able to obtain an extra discount on the ferry crossing of \$240.

We are getting back into gear having just held our first committee meeting for the year, and have planned this year's AGM for the 9th March, so now is your opportunity to nominate to take a position in 2021-2022.

We are looking at ways to encourage new members, and clubs, to the association. We are having another attempt at having committee personnel available to visit affiliated club rallies, as a day or rally visitor where required, to provide the opportunity for members to ask questions etc..

The state rally committee have set a date to pick up the batten for our rally in Pittsworth, and we wish them all the best and that we have a clear run for the running of the rally in September.

On the subject of rallies, the planning for National Rally in Barmera S A is also proceeding well, and they are looking for members to keep up with registrations. In the last newsletter it was reported that there was only non-potable water available on the site, however I have followed up on this and they are arranging for there to be supplies of potable water delivered in tankers during the rally with the method of distribution still to be finalised.

Both the NACC (National Association of Caravan Clubs) and RVCAL (RV Clubs Australia Ltd) have held their respective AGM's, and will be holding the first of their 2021 meetings in the near future.

In case you have not seen the reports on a couple of incidents where solar panels have come adrift from the roof of Caravans we are now being encouraged to have the mounting of these panels checked from time to time. The last incident caused the death of two people in Tasmania.

We have been made aware that in Qld we have licensed gas certifiers when you want to sell your van but these people are not qualified to carry out gas repairs, and this has caused some problems for owners along with extra expense.

I do hope that you are all in a position to hit the roads again and that our clubs are back up and running, we have unfortunately lost a couple of clubs in recent times and I do hope that we do not lose any more. We need to support our clubs to keep them up and running so bring forward any suggestions that you feel may help your clubs to grow, and also share those ideas with other clubs and the CCQ.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

Another year has dawned – let's hope it is better than 2020 and that we can all start doing what we caravanners like to do – hitch up our vans and get out there exploring this great country of ours.

As you will see from the notice in this issue of the Bulletin, the CCQ will hold its AGM on Tuesday, 9 March 2021 in the Annerley Baptist Church Hall, 560 Ipswich Road, Annerley.

Even though it isn't that long since last year's AGM which took place via ZOOM in November 2020 (just a few short months ago), to abide by our Rules and to get back on track, it is necessary to hold the AGM within three months of the end of the financial year — which, for the CCQ, is 31 January.

Please note the change from the usual Monday night to hold these meetings to **Tuesday night**. All positions on the Committee will be declared vacant so why not consider putting your hand up to take on a position.

Regrettably, the resignation of another our affiliated clubs was accepted at the end of 2020 – Fraser Coast Caravan Club Inc. who had joined the CCQ in 2006. We thank their members for their past contribution to the CCQ and wish them well in their future endeavours.

As Affiliation Fees come in, it enables the CCQ to gauge how club memberships are going. Looking back on past records, the peak seemed to be in 2009 when 33 affiliated clubs recorded 1166 memberships.

Looking at data for this current financial year, there are now 29 affiliated clubs with a membership of 1021 units. This has prompted the CCQ to do a membership drive and invitations are being drafted to encourage non-affiliated clubs to join the CCQ. If any members know of such a club, please let me have contact details and I will include them in the invitations to go out.

New updated brochures on Joining a Caravan Club are also in the pipeline and, once available, these will be distributed to caravan sales/repair yards and relevant businesses for passing on to their customers.

The latest update from the Southern Downs Regional Council about allowing caravan clubs to use Killarney Showgrounds, in particular, for rallies states that Council has endorsed development of a camping options strategy and drafting of a new planning scheme has started in-house with a commitment to "definitely" consult with the CCQ and other relevant bodies when that stage of the plan is reached.

Disappointingly, a couple of clubs had to abandon their January club rally when the Greater Brisbane area was put into lockdown but best to be safe. Here's hoping we are back on track to enjoy our rallies and caravanning again.

GAS CERTIFICATES

Warning to caravanners to take care when selling vans and having to get a Gas Certificate. Make sure a fully qualified Gas Fitter is booked and not just a holder of a Gas Certifier Licence.

The following are extracts from the:

Petroleum and Gas Inspectorate Guideline for gas safety and compliance Caravans, camper trailers and recreational vehicles January 2019

Queensland provides two types of gas work license in relation to gas work on a gas system installed in a caravan:

2 an unrestricted or unconditioned gas work license (full)

② a service and caravan certification gas work license.

GAS WORK LICENSE HOLDERS

FULL LICENSE

Gas system installation work must only be undertaken by the holder of a full gas work license. On completion of the installation work, whether it is a complete gas system or an extension to an existing gas system, the installer must issue a gas compliance certificate for the installation work performed.

Apprentices and trainee gas installers

Any gas work conducted by a gas apprentice or trainee must only be performed under the direct supervision and presence of a gas work license holder.

SERVICE AND CARAVAN CERTIFICATION LICENSE

Holders of a gas work license 'Service and caravan certification' cannot perform installation work. In addition, they cannot provide supervision of apprentices or trainees for the purposes of installation work.

They can service gas appliances, including disconnecting and reconnecting a gas appliance for the purpose of maintenance or repair. They cannot replace a faulty appliance with a 'new' appliance; this is installation work and requires the holder of a full gas work license. Unlike service work, the replacement of an appliance instigates the requirement to upgrade the appliance installation in line with the requirements of the current standard.
