50 Years of Social Carefree Caravanning

The Sunshine Caravan Club of Queensland Inc was formed in 1973 at a meeting held at a private residence in Mt Gravatt. The Club conducted its first Rally on the 14th and 15th April 1973.

Members stay with the Club for many years. For example, Fritz and Maureen Van Bruggen joined the Club in 1974 and remain active members to this day.

Many of the founding members have passed on, however they left a legacy of a great, friendly and family caravan club.

The Club is "Incorporated" under the "Associations Incorporate Act" (QLD) 1981 and is affiliated with the Caravan Clubs of Queensland Inc. The Club operates under a Constitution and By-Laws which limits the number of caravans in the Club to forty (40).

Like most other bodies we have evolved over time and the term "Caravan" should probably now be referred to as a "Recreational Vehicle".

The Club's Motto has always been "Social Carefree Caravanning" and has been formed on members and not on residential location. We have members located as far afield as Bundaberg, Gympie, Toowoomba, Burleigh Waters, Kingaroy, Ipswich, Warwick and the Greater Brisbane Area. We are currently at full strength and potential new members will go on a waiting list.

Our 50th Birthday celebration will be held at Lowood Showgrounds in April, with a Morning Tea followed by a Luncheon to which Ordinary Members, Life Members and Associate Members have been invited.

AN EXPLANATION OF THE LEVELS OF REPRESENTATION FOR CARAVAN CLUB MEMBERS



The State Association for Queensland Caravan Clubs

The Caravan Clubs of Queensland Inc (CCQ) is a non-profit organisation providing a united voice for affiliated caravan clubs in Queensland.

The CCQ on behalf of affiliated clubs and club members throughout Queensland is able to make representation to all levels of Governments and businesses for the benefit of the caravanning fraternity.

The CCQ provides a common bonding link between all affiliated caravan clubs in Queensland and throughout Australia. The CCQ also facilitates the annual State Rally and the National Rally when held in Queensland.

The CCQ is managed by a volunteer executive committee elected at the Annual General Meeting by Club Delegates. The executive committee meets as required to manage business and to make recommendations at Delegates Meetings. Two club members from each of the affiliated clubs represent their club at the Delegates Meetings. Northern clubs unable to attend may be represented at these meeting by proxy members.

Benefits of Affiliation for Caravan Clubs:

- access to Public Liability Insurance at a greatly discounted rate
- access to venues where a Certificate of Currency for Public Liability Insurance is required
- access to venues that are limited to caravan clubs only
- access to a channel of communication between Local, State and Federal authorities. This may
 be in matters relating to safe travelling, caravanning, camping and other topics that may be
 of interest or concern to the caravanning members.
- the opportunity to network with Caravan clubs throughout all states of Australia

Benefits of Affiliation for Caravan Club Members:

- access to discounts offered by businesses to affiliated caravan club members
- entitlement to attend the State Caravan Clubs Rallies as organised
- entitlement to attend the National Caravan Clubs Rally held every three years in a different State
- discounted site fees at caravan parks and showgrounds
- the opportunity to become an active participant in the organisation and management of the affiliated club as visitors, the opportunity to attend rallies held by other clubs

HISTORY

In 1970/71 the very first National Rally was held at Mildura and was organised by the Caravan Club of South Australia. Six clubs were in attendance at this rally.

Further National Rallies were organised by the different state associations and it was not until 1990 at the 7th National Rally that a decision was made to form an Australian Association of Caravan Clubs.

In 1993 at the 8th National Rally the National Association of Caravan Clubs was formed and became incorporated. Each State Association took turns at being the National Secretariat for a three year period and was responsible for organising the National Rally at the end of their three year tenure.

Since incorporated Associations are typically State based, it became increasingly clear that a national body needed to be under Federal jurisdiction and after much work, it was agreed to change the National Association to a Company Limited by Guarantee under the Corporations Act.
