Breakdown Assistance on Private Roads

Trans Urban will not allow RACQ roadside assistance on the 4 roads in QLD they control - Clem 7, 2nd Toowoomba Range Crossing, Gateway and Logan Motorway.

Trans Urban monitor their roads with cameras and will send a bump truck and/or motorbike with basic tools to lend assistance, as this is included in the price of the tolls. If they can't get you going, they will take you to a safe location, off their network, then contact RACQ to give you your full entitlement of roadside assistance.

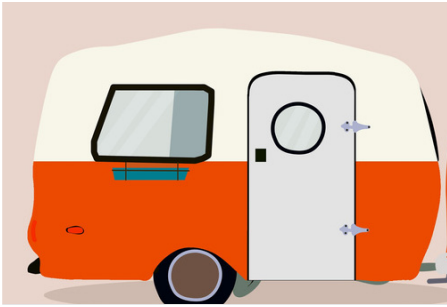
News from CCQ Delegate Meeting
